From the 2015 Committee Consultation:

Each committee will adhere to the laws and follow the guidelines of the Church of England.

Communicate regularly with the PTS PCC.

Comply with all requests from the PCC to enable valid insurance and safeguarding to be in place for events in and for the church.

Each church committee will work with the PTS Rector and Wardens to

- ◆ Liaise within the church and village community
- ◆ Attend and publicize worship and encourage others to do the same
- ◆ Plan and manage social events within the parish and in particular their own village
- ◆ Join in income generation for the parish
- ◆ Manage the housekeeping of the respective Church building and encourage volunteers
- ◆ Appoint a convenor to arrange dates according to the PTS calendar, a chair person and a secretary/note taker to provide a report to the PCC of Committee meetings
- ◆ Share with other PTS PCC committees in the care of the building and church yard

Committee members are invited, and strongly recommended, to join with the other PTS committee members on Away Days, 1 annual committee members' meeting and 1 Annual Parochial Church meeting, and joint parish worship.

Don't forget **Green Gym** helping to look after St James churchyard. Next dates are **6 July** and **15 July**. Lots of mowing, strimming and weeding to be done!
